- Led the automation of manual file cleaning and prep, saving over \$40k in processing labor annually.
- Managed rollout of automation effort and development of Python script kits across maps.

- Spearheaded the complete rebuild of Podio apps and database infrastructure within 45 days, optimizing reproducibility and cutting the new branch onboarding process by 75%.

- Partnered with the CFO to automate a complex 67-step financing process, drastically reducing the time required by their team to close loans and accelerating the startup's funding capabilities.
- Built a custom inventory management app (hosted on a self-maintained Windows laptop server) to enable access for on-site rental/equipment sales reps to real-time (15-minute lag) inventory data independently, reducing unnecessary daily admin calls, which cut admin time and increased sales.
